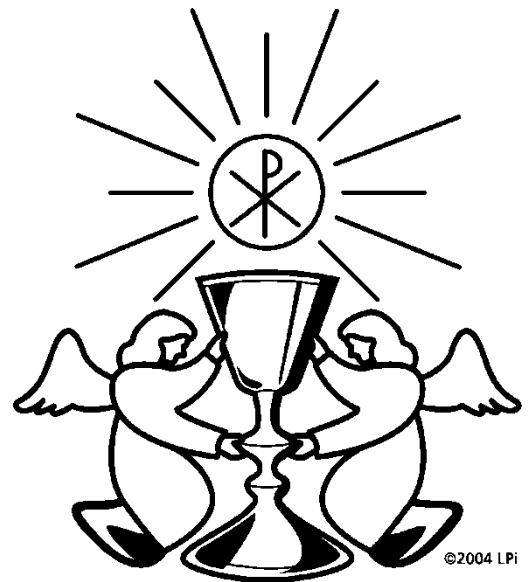

Did You Know?...Ask Fr. Ron

Corpus Christi

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, commonly called Corpus Christi. First celebrated in 1246, Corpus Christi was both a doctrinal response to heretical teachings regarding the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist and also an expression of ardent popular devotion to the Blessed Sacrament. In 1264, Pope Urban IV extended its celebration to the entire Latin Church and commissioned St. Thomas Aquinas to compose a special Mass and Office. Celebrated on its traditional day – the Thursday after Trinity Sunday – Corpus Christi is one of the 10 holydays of obligation in the universal calendar. In places (such as the United States) where it is no longer a holyday of obligation, its observance is transferred to Sunday.

In many places, Corpus Christi is the occasion for public honor to the Blessed Sacrament in the form of a splendid outdoor procession. (As a seminarian in 1984, I had the privilege of witnessing the impressive Corpus Christi procession held in Montreal.) In common with other less elaborate forms of Eucharistic exposition and adoration, this procession (and the Rite of Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament with which it concludes) constitute one prolonged act of worship, beginning with the celebration of the Mass at which the sacred host was originally consecrated, one prolonged expression of our faith in, and our experience of, the presence of God-with-us.
