CHURCH IN LATIN AMERICA and the CATHOLIC HOME MISSIONS

Dear Friends in the Lord:

On the weekend of August 7 & 8, the archdiocese will once again take up a special collection for the *Church in Latin America* and the *Catholic Home Missions*, which, though raising funds for corners of the world, have a similar purpose.

The *Church in Latin America* and *the Caribbean* is vibrant and rich in faith as well as growing in numbers as never before. It is, however, lacking in material resources. The proceeds from this collection will enable (arch)dioceses, parishes, communities of religious, seminaries, and other Catholic institutions in these nations to continue training and forming priests, women and men religious, missionaries, and catechists so that the Church might continue to serve our poor, sick, and struggling brothers and sisters in the Lord as they deserve to be served.

The *Catholic Home Missions* is another national collection, the proceeds of which remain here in the United States – our own sector of the Lord’s vineyard. Many people in Appalachia, the Deep South, and the Rocky Mountain States, as you know from the news media, struggle on a daily basis simply to survive. This collection affords each of us an opportunity to assist our local Church in a very special way, by enabling parishes, schools, and charitable institutions of the Church to provide for the needs of literally millions of needy Catholic Americans.

With this letter, I ask that you consider a generous gift in support of these two crucially important and most worthy causes. They are truly the work of the Lord in our midst.
