The Pastor's Column

Welcome Sr. Elizabeth!

This weekend we have the pleasure to welcome Sr. Elizabeth Ogbu, DDL of the Daughters of Divine Love. She will be speaking at all the weekend masses as part of the Society of the Propagation of the Faith's annual Mission Co-op Appeal. This effort seeks to foster the spirit of missionary activity in the Church and to encourage prayer and financial help for missionary outreach and mission churches in the United States and around the world. The Paulist Fathers are among thousands of religious communities who make it their mission to reach out to all and spread the Good News through word and deed.

Sr. Elizabeth's community, the Daughters of Divine Love, was founded in 1969 in Nigeria and currently has over 900 professed members. The Sisters are engaged in a variety of apostolates around the world, including here in the U.S. They work where the manifestation of God's love is needed the most. They work among the very poor of our society: the rejected, the homeless, challenged children and adults. They also work in parishes, schools, hospitals. They build houses for the homeless, provide food and clothing to those in need, provide potable drinking water, generators for electricity, and hospital

equipment.



Sr. Elizabeth will share her experiences as a missionary and that of her community. She will also invite our monetary support. They are in special need of financial aid to continue their apostolates in Cuba, Jamaica, Haiti, and African countries. In addition, they need funds for the formation of their novices and postulants as well as for the education of sisters for their individual apostolates. The second collection taken up this weekend will go to support the Society of the Propagation of the Faith and the mission of the Daughters of Divine Love.

As we hear Sister Elizabeth's talk this weekend, we are reminded that through our baptism we are all called to be missionaries. May her witness inspire all of us to go out to all the world and tell the Good News!

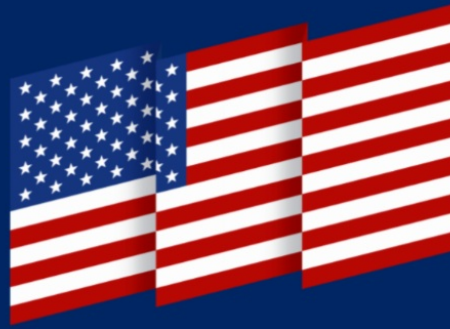

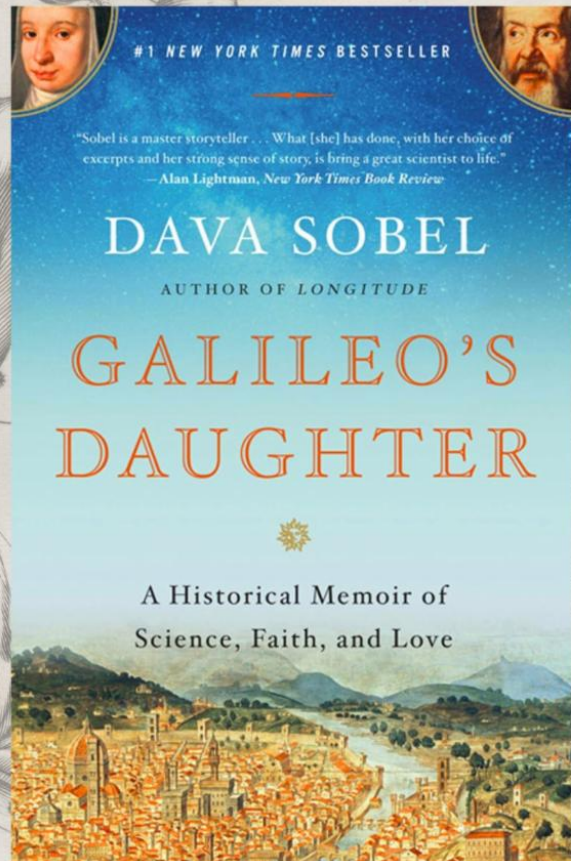
